Completed

- Electrical meter base moved to north side of building and new power line drop installed per IPL
 Engineering; electrical work performed by Ashbaugh Electric, Inc.
- Crawl space is encapsulated and clean up completed.
- Basement and garage are de-cluttered, cleaned, and organized.
- Repaired 3 large picnic tables with treated wood (work performed by me and Scott Sweet, Clubhouse Manager).
- Clubhouse shingles replaced.
- Fireplace chimney rebuilt and damaged flue tile/liner repaired.
- New keyless entry on clubhouse front door procured and installed by Ross Sexter, Vice President (installation performed by Ross at no cost to HOA).
- Double-metal doors installed in basement/garage; this improvement allows for easier access and storage of pool furniture, equipment; etc.

One last goal remains that I set for myself when I joined the board a year and a half ago. My remaining goal is to replace ancient windows in the upstairs at a cost of \$6,000. My mission is to have our clubhouse reflect the nice properties in our neighborhood.


