Grounds Report

Hello Friends and Neighbors! I have several updates to share with you below:

- The March rainstorm brought down a few trees along the creek on the Lakeview Drive side of the HOA property. The downed trees were removed and overhanging limbs were trimmed up.
- Trees along Lakeshore Drive East were trimmed and overhanging limbs removed.
- Temporary boat storage is available behind the pool on a first come basis as space is limited. The requirement is that **your name and phone number must be visible on the boat/watercraft.**
- Trees in the front yard along the parking circle have been trimmed.
- Other areas on the grounds have had grass seed sown to eliminate the bare spots.
- The grounds are being nicely groomed by our lawn service who works very closely with me.
- A dam inspection is required this year and will be scheduled in early August. The inspection will cover
 the spillway portions of the dam owned by the Association and will also include portions of the dam that
 are owned by resident members who live on the lake.

Kayaks, Canoes, and Paddleboats

LAKE TREATMENTS

The lake is professionally treated twice a month April through October to eliminate nuisance, non-native aquatic weeks, and algae. The safest products are used and, when possible, many natural and biological solutions are applied. The woodlandshomeowners.org website is updated twice a month after each treatment.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE AND RULES ABOUT WOODLANDS SPILLWAY AND DAM AREA

Please kindly observe the following rules regarding the spillway and dam behind the WHOA Clubhouse, and please share these rules with your family. Report inappropriate behavior to the Woodlands Grounds Director woodlandsgrounds@yahoo.com.

- Do not play on any part of the rocky portion of the dam (this is not safe).
- Do not move stones (called "riprap") from off the sides of the **spillway channel** and into the channel.
- Do not move/relocate/pile up/collect the stones ("riprap") from the dam and build other structures, walkways, castles, towers campfires, etc.
- After moderate/heavy rains stay away from dam altogether and stay away from the rushing water in the creeks.
- Do not leave boats or watercraft on the dam or spillway.
- Vehicles and boat trailers are not allowed to be parked on the dam at any time.

- 1. Presuming all goes well (mechanicals, permits, water chemistry, etc.) our planned opening is Saturday, May 29th.

Successful Lessons

Due to the COVID-19 crisis this past summer, we were only able to offer tennis lessons in the month of July. Despite this, we had a great turnout and experience for all. Overall, we had 29 kids participate in lessons. Our instructor, Ellen Gardner, was absolutely fantastic! The growth the kids made in their tennis abilities over the one-month period was very evident. We look forward to a full summer of tennis lessons in 2021. We hope to see your kids there!

Seasonal Information

It is our goal to keep the nets up as long as we can this year. Tennis is a wonderful way to play a socially distanced sport. Because we will be purchasing new nets and poles for the spring, we are willing to keep our current nets up longer. We will send out an email to alert you when we plan to take the nets down for the winter.

Additional Information

In the past month, we have installed a new locking system to the tennis gate. It is not quite ready to use at this time. Once it is ready, we will send out information about how to access the courts using the new lock. It is our hope that once this is in place, our courts will only be used by Woodlands members and their guests. There have been many we have found to be non-residents using our courts because we did not have a lock.

2021 SWIM LESSON ENROLLMENT FORM

REGISTRATION begins when the pool opens (currently planned on May 29th) at 10:00 a.m. Please turn in Form(s) and payment to any lifeguard as well as to confirm class availability (subject to change). An enrollment form can also be found at www.woodlandshomeowners.org. There will be no make-ups for rain days or missed classes.

Lessons will be held Monday-Friday for a ONE-week period. You may sign up for multiple sessions. Cost per session per swimmer is \$25 cash or check (Session I \$20) payable to Woodlands Homeowners Association. Payment must accompany form and homeowner must be in good standing. Classes are filled on a first-come basis. Swimmers will be grouped based on ability and age. By signing up for swim lessons, you acknowledge that it is the responsibility of the Pool Managers and staff to move children up OR down in level based on ability and space. Please review the group levels and circle the name of the group that would be most beneficial to your child (this does not guarantee that class). If the class is not full, it may be cancelled or combined with another class.

Minnows: Child learns to be comfortable in the water. Work on putting face in and floating. Children learn the arm movements of swimming and kicking. They also lean to get back to the wall if they fall or jump in. (Kids sit on the steps.)

Flying Fish: Child needs to be comfortable in the water and be able to swim a little by themselves. Children learn freestyle with side breathing. They also learn the backstroke.

Sting Rays: Children need to be able to swim the width of the pool without stopping. Work is done on freestyle and backstroke while learning breaststroke and diving.

Marlins: Child should be able to swim the width of the pool backstroke and freestyle. Continue working on breaststroke and learn butterfly. Also work on starts, finishes, and turns.

Sharks: Child needs to know all four strokes and be able to swim a lap of each legally. Work on stroke technique, starts, turns, finishes, and speed.
