GONE FISHING, CATCH YOU LATER

LAKE AND GROUNDS UPDATE - JUDY ROUHSELANG

I have been talking to our members about their wonderful fishing experiences on our Woodlands Lake. Members say that "this is the best small lake for fishing anywhere" and they have provided several pictures below of "great catches." Feel free to send pictures of your "great catches" to grounds@woodlandshomeowners.org

Frank Petrarca tells me that he has fished the lake every year going on 21 years now and he cannot tell you how many huge fish he has caught in the lake. There are huge crappie, bass & bluegill/redear sunfish in the lake. Below is a picture of the very first bass Frank caught this year, and he says that 3 to 3 & ½ inch chartreuse crappie jigs work very well for both crappie & bass. Another picture below is of a huge crappie pic from 2019. Texas-style rubber worms in purple or motor oil colored work extremely well for bass when the temps get warmer, crappie jigs hit year-round on both bass & crappie." Frank says, "I'll take anyone fishing that wants to go."

There are also extremely large hybrid striped bass and the picture far below is probably close to 10 pounds.

IMPORTANT MESSAGE AND RULES ABOUT WOODLANDS SPILLWAY AND DAM AREA

Please kindly observe the following rules regarding the spillway and dam behind the WHOA Clubhouse, and please share these rules with your family. Report inappropriate behavior to the Woodlands Grounds Director grounds@woodlandshomeowners.org

- Do not play on any part of the rocky portion of the dam (this is not safe).
- Do not move stones (called "riprap") from off the sides of the spillway channel and into the channel.
- Do not move/relocate/pile up/collect the stones ("riprap") from the dam and block the waterflow on the spillway.
- Do not build other structures, walkways, castles, towers, campfires, etc.
- After moderate/heavy rains stay away from dam altogether and stay away from the rushing water in the creeks.
- Do not leave boats or watercraft on the dam or spillway.
- Vehicles and boat trailers are not allowed to be parked on the dam at any time.

Hello neighbors,

I want to introduce myself as the new Pool Director and provide some updates on the 2022 pool season. I have lived in the neighborhood with my wife and three sons for 8 years. We spent most warm summer days at the pool, so this role made sense for me!

2022 SEASON DATES & HOURS:

POOL GATE

There is now an access-coded lock on the front gate at the pool entrance. This added security measure has been planned for several years. It allows families to simply enter a pre-assigned code rather than "sign-in" with a lifeguard. What is your code?! Don't worry...for the first few weeks of summer, the gate will be kept open (like previous years) and a guard will be at the entrance to give you your family code.

POOL MANAGEMENT

The Board recently transitioned certain aspects of pool management to Aquatic Management of Indianapolis. Aquatic will be responsible for hiring lifeguards (from our neighborhood if possible), common pool maintenance, pool opening (start of season), and pool closure (end of season). Aquatic already manages several of our adjacent neighborhood pools and they're a top-rated company in this space.

Both sessions will be aimed at younger, less-experienced swimmers so please consider swim team or private lessons if your child can already swim across the pool.
