Despite all the highs and lows, we made it to another beautiful Indiana summer with just a few minor changes! Our HOA was blessed for many years having Judy Rouhselang oversee the grounds duties, but she decided it was time to pass the opportunity along. So without further a due, it's a please to introduce myself as the new grounds' director for this wonderful Woodlands HOA.

My amazing partner Sarah and I have been residing here since September 2017 with our two pups (Yogi Charles & Patrick Ryan). We have had the privilege of meeting many residents personally, over the years and others have probably seen Yogi the German Shorthair Pointer pulling me on a bike up and down our streets with a light strapped to my head after a long day work just itching to get his energy out. #### Now for important stuff!!

As the summer season kicks off, many of our residents have inquired about watercraft registration, storage & lake use:

- Watercraft use on the lake is for woodland residents only.
- Watercraft storage (kayaks, canoes & paddle boats) is on a first come, first served basis and must be registered with the HOA at the start of each season (storage is at capacity for the 2023 season).
- Watercrafts that are taken home after each use (not stored behind the pool) are not required to be registered.
- Lakefront property owners with a watercraft, please ensure your assets are securely tied up to prevent damage to your and other neighbors' property.

#### IMPORTANT MESSAGE AND RULES ABOUT WOODLANDS SPILLWAY AND DAM AREA

We ask that all Woodland homeowners please observe the following rules regarding the spillway and dam behind the WHOA Clubhouse, and please share these rules with your family. If you see or feel that there is an issue, we ask that you please report it to the Woodlands Grounds Director @ grounds@woodlandshomeowners.org

- Please do not play on any part of the rocky portion of the dam (this is not safe).
- Do not move stones (called "riprap") from off the sides of the spillway channel and into the channel.
- Do not move/relocate/pile up/collect the stones ("riprap") from the dam and block the waterflow on the spillway.
- Do not build other structures, walkways, castles, towers, campfires, etc.
- After moderate/heavy rains stay away from dam altogether and stay away from the rushing water in the creeks.
- Do not leave boats or watercraft on the dam or spillway.
- Vehicles and boat trailers are not allowed to be parked on the dam at any time.
